GIANT RYAN pressed the pace from the two path throughout, then finished tenaciously under a stiff drive to wear down the leader in the closing strides. HEIR TO THE STONE was bumped after stumbling at the start, raced with striking distance while travelling in the four path, commenced his rally after turning for home, closed ground gamely the entire length of the stretch. SEEYOUATSERGIOS saved ground until the quarter pole and finished willingly to grab the show. HEAD HEART HOOF set the pace along the inside, dug in stubbornly in upper stretch when challengers appeared on the scene, before grudgingly relinquishing the lead in the late stages. PAPA CHARLIE failed to reach a contending position. SMOKIN HERO bobbled at the break and was never involved. GOLD PROSPECT saved ground throughout. NATTY MEBOY bumped at the start, was outrun for three-quarters, was checked and taken outward several paths turning for home to avoid the fallen rival. J T MOORE raced three wide and faded after going a half. ROUTINE ADDENDUM took the inside route, clipped heels and fell heavily in the vicinity of the quarter pole. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the incident in upper stretch before the result was declared official.
