MUCH FANFARE set the pace on the inside, dueled on the far turn, dug in determinedly past midstretch and was all out to prevail after a prolonged three way stretch battle. HOOSKIRT raced off the pace inside, was well placed on the far turn, bid three wide entering the stretch and finished gamely outside. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER stalked inside, moved up to press the pace, dueled outside the winner on the far turn and dug in gamely between rivals through the stretch. CHALK PLAYER raced off the pace, advanced on the turn and gained mildly. THERE GOES MOLLY did not factor. AURIC GIRL raced outside a rival, came three wide into the lane and failed to respond. MY NAN NELL (IRE) raced off the rail and faded.
