JONESY BOY trailed the field, moved up passing the quarter pole, swung wide, closed strongly outside and was up in time. DON DULCE tracked inside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, came four wide into the lane, gained command nearing the eighth pole then dug in gamely to the finish. SPA CITY FEVER brushed the gate, stalked outside, moved up three wide to contest the pace, dueled three wide on the far turn and weakened. PERCUSSION vied inside, dueled on the far turn and tired. SLIVER AND ONIONS stumbled at the start, vied outside in the early stages, then dueled between rivals and tired.
