COMANDANTE pressed the pace from the three path, came under a drive swinging three wide in upper stretch, seized command straightening away, edged away to the furlong marker, dug in under a drive to hold his closest pursuer at bay to the wire. KNOCKHER OFF wide early in mid pack down the backside, shifted to the two path at the seven-sixteenths, progressed under light coaxing through the turn into prominence when swinging three wide at the quarter pole, offered up a good kick to secure the place honors unable to reel in the aforementioned rival in the late stages. GHOSTLY VISION four wide in pursuit of the front from close range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. COBALTO chased two to three wide from mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide for home, gained mildly through the stretch to secure the last major share while unable to threaten the top. COOL AND QUIET set a prompted pace from just off the inside, cut the corner roused into the stretch, yielded the lead straightening for home and weakened in the lane. THE BIG DELUXE steadied when squeezed between rivals due to pressure from the outside of UNCLE MITCHO, settled just off the inside towards the rear, came under a drive three furlongs out and offered no kick. UNCLE MITCHO broke in at the start squeezing THE BIG DELUXE against BRASS PEAR, was outrun early on and proved no menace. BRASS PEAR bumped lightly at the start, lost action nearing the five-eighths pole, was quickly put to a protective hold, pulled up and subsequently vanned off.
