JEFF'S TROPHIES quickly showed in front, set the pace and tired in the stretch. LIVELY MELODY raced wide throughout and offered a mild rally outside. LA FEMME M raced inside and had no rally. NATIVE TALK had no response when roused. HOLY BOLLA stumbled at the start, chased along the inside and tired. CHUG BUD was pulled up after a half mile and was vanned off.
