Footnotes

PENTATONIC, just off the pace, made a bid outside the top two on the final turn, dueled while bearing in, exchanging bumps with STROLLIONG BELLE through the stretch then was clear late. STROLLING BELLE stalked the pace, dueled briefly clear on the turn home, came slightly out in the upper stretch then dueled while exchanging bumps with PENTATONIC through the stretch, was forced in, altered course to the outside late and couldn't recover momentum. REINE AMANDINE (FR) was unhurried, angled to the outside in the upper stretch then rallied finishing well. LA VILLE ROUGE, just off the pace, rallied in stride with PENTATONIC on the far turn, was close inside late then lost momentum. KRIS PIT was unhurried, angled widest into the stretch then had no rally. SERRA LAKE, just off the pace on the outside, dropped back on the final turn then weakened. SAZARAC JAZZ rated the pace, contended the lead to the middle of the final turn then gave way in the stretch. After a stewards inquiry and a subsequent claim of foul, the stewards disqualified the winner and placed her second for bearing in on STROLLING BELLE through the stretch, causing the latter to check and alter course late.
