WON FAST BULLET vied inside, dueled on the far turn, dug in gamely past midstretch and was all out to save the place. CINNAMON BEACH pressed the pace, dueled on the far turn, dug in gamely in upper stretch and just missed for second. WINAHOLIC raced off the pace on the inside, waited for room turning for home, lacked room in upper stretch and gained mildly late when clear. MY PIANO MAN stalked outside, bid three wide at the quarter pole and weakened. TAP ATTACK raced off the rail and had no rally. FAIR WHIT raced close up between foes and faded. SETTLE FOR MEDAL did not factor.
