DAVID quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, drew away when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. CARRY MY COLORS rated along inside, was roused on the second turn, could not get to the winner but was clearly best of the others. TICKLE ME RED put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. MACHINE TO TOWER put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. FOURTH AND SIX lacked a rally. RUSHING BRUSH raced with the pace from the outside and tired after three quarters. SIXTH MAN was rank in the gate and reared at the start, losing any chance. IAN'S THUNDER was outrun. PRIVATE CALL had no response when roused. PLATO'S LOVE was outrun.
