Footnotes

PRINCE OF PEACE raced close up inside, bid outside of FEROCIOUS WON entering the stretch and gradually wore down that rival to prevail. FEROCIOUS WON set the pace on the inside and fought gamely to the finish. TOUGH AND EASY chased between rivals and weakened. ZIP ZIP raced off the pace, angled out and had no rally. FIREMIST raced off the pace between rivals early, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. PICKETT'S PRIME raced well off the pace and closed belatedly inside. RED ZIPPER chased outside and tired. QUICK WITTED chased three wide and tired. MATT'S A MILLION did not factor. A MILLION AND TEN did not factor. VICARISH chased four wide and faded. GOTTAHAVEACAT was outrun. A Jockey's Objection by the rider of the runner up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was disallowed.
