Footnotes

BRUSHED ON raced just off the pace while saving ground, slipped through along the rail to gain the lead in upper stretch then drifted out considerably while fully extended to hold off FANTACULAR in the final strides. FANTACULAR was bumped at the start after breaking slowly, rallied three wide on the turn and finished well in the middle of the track but could not get up. GRANDPA ED sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace slightly off the rail into upper stretch and held for a share. TOP OFFICIAL broke inward a bit at the start, raced just outside the winner to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. LEE'S SONNET failed to threaten with a late run along the rail. WOLF BOY was bumped after breaking slowly, never reached contention while racing wide. RUBY HILL was never a factor. SPEEDLIMITSIXTY raced within striking distance along the inside for a half and faded in the drive. SHIMMER ME QUICK was outrun.
