MOM'S DREAM broke somewhat awkwardly then raced unhurriedly, was eased out entering the stretch, steadily advanced to late stretch then dug in determinedly for the win. SEASONAL CHANGE rated off the pace toward the inside, made a bid nearing the quarter pole then dueled to a short late lead but was outfinished in the final stride. BALLYBUNION was kept off the pace, made her bid into the final turn, took a short lead to the inside of the tiring pacesetter in the upper stretch then dueled stubbornly through the stretch but let go in the final strides. T. V. SECRETARY raced unhurriedly to the top of the stretch, gathered momentum through the stretch, closed, then leveled off. KRIS'SBEST rated off the pace off the rail, gave chase through the final turn then had no stretch response. SHIRL THE TWIRL drew to a long early lead, lost some ground while tiring entering the stretch and was through. ST. HELENAS SECRET, off the pace, showed no response through the final turn.
