BOHEMIAN LADY showed good early speed racing four wide, bid three wide at the quarter pole and drew away in the stretch under urging. DEPUTY SQUEALIE dueled inside and stayed on gamely while well clear of the others. RUNAWAY ELEANOR raced off the pace, advanced inside and rallied up the rail to earn the show award. FORGOTTEN PROMISE raced inside, was steadied going into the turn and then outfinished for third. GEORGETOWN GAL dueled three wide for the early lead, then battled between rivals into the lane and weakened. ELUSIVE PROJECT advanced inside, angled out and had no rally. MISS MIDAS raced four wide on the turn and bumped with GOLDEN JEWEL at the quarter pole. L C MYSTERY did not factor. SOCIETY'S CHILD, off slowly, did not factor. GOLDEN JEWEL raced five wide on the turn and was bumped off stride at the quarter pole. BOLTON LANDING between foes and faded. GOOD AND HOT dueled between rivals for the opening quarter and then gave way.
