PUMA'S PRIDE raced off the pace, came four wide into the lane, rallied steadily on the outside in the final furlong and was up in time. REACHING UP dueled three wide for the advantage, pulled clear in upper stretch and was caught in the final strides. APRIL TRUST was pinched back at the break, swung wide passing the quarter pole and finished well outside. AVA ANNE chased inside and weakened. TIGER'S REIGN closed belatedly inside. ZAT DARN CAT chased four wide and tired. THE RODEO EXPRESS dueled inside and tired. PRINCESS PETRIZZO raced between rivals and tired. JET SET JAZZ did not factor. TALESPIN was outrun. GENEVIL dueled for the lead and stopped. FLYING PICKLE was outrun and eased in the stretch.
