

SAVEDBYTHELIGHT pressed the pace racing outside of CITY FIRE, moved alongside that one to challenge at the quarter pole and drew clear, driving. QUEEN'S TRIOMPHE was well placed on the inside, split rivals in the three path in upper stretch and closed gamely to earn the place award. RETROACTIVE saved ground racing off the pace, came through between rivals in the stretch and closed well inside. JULIE'S PRIZE raced three wide in the early stages, rallied five wide into the lane and failed to sustain that bid. CAUGHT IN THE RAIN raced off the rail, made a four wide move on the far turn and flattened out. CONSORT MUSIC saved ground and failed to respond. CITY FIRE rated the pace on the rail and faltered in the stretch. LADY LIBERTY raced between rivals and tired. CALL AN AUDIBLE rated three wide and tired. KABYLIA (IRE) was squeezed at the start and outrun.
