BALLYLEE stalked outside, bid three wide entering the turn, rallied outside and drew clear. FADE TO BLACK set the pace and could not stay with the winner. PALESTRINA raced three wide early, then saved ground and gained mildly. LIFT raced between rivals, saved ground on the far turn and lacked a winning bid. RACHEL'S TEMPER bobbled and was bumped at the break, raced three wide early, then between foes, three wide on the far turn and came five wide into the stretch. COLONEL JUANITA raced four wide early, three wide on the far turn and weakened. SARATOGA LAKE raced three wide early, then saved ground and failed to threaten. COCOA was bumped at the start and outrun. STAR MAGNOLIA was bumped after the start, stalked, bid between rivals and faded. GOLDEN MARIA lunged and stumbled soon after the start, then raced awkwardly, rank and was distanced.
