START JUMPING raced two wide early, saved ground turning for home, rallied mildly and just missed for the place. JETER chased between rivals and weakened. MEWANNAROSE broke in bumping a rival at the start, raced inside and lacked a rally. SOKITUMI SAMURAI was bumped at the start, chased three wide and tired. DEMON'S DEPUTY raced off the inside and did not factor. LEAD SINGER raced off the pace inside and did not factor. CRACKERJACK JONES chased inside and faded.
