Footnotes

SWEET TALKIN BABE bobbled slightly at the break, raced just off the pace down the backstretch, moved up outside the top two on the turn, had her rider lose his whip at the top of the stretch, continued her bid through the stretch and was edging clear near the sixteenth pole. FAIR KATE rated off the pace, made her bid from the quarter pole and closed late for place. YOU AND I BABE pressured the pace, dueled to a short lead on the turn, continued in her bid to midstretch then reluctantly let go in the final sixteenth. BREADKNIFE set a pressured pace, dueled through the stretch but leveled off in the final sixteenth. BRIGHTEST chased the pace then was empty through the stretch. IT'S A LARK broke awkwardly then was shuffled back at the start, showed no speed early on and passed some tiring rivals through the stretch. BRAVEHEARTED LADY chased the pace from the inside then tired. SWIFT PLACE was a bit fractious just before the break and mildly unprepared for the start, made a middle move through the backstretch then was through for the drive. CUSHINA chased the pace down the backstretch, dropped back through the turn then tired. SIMPLY RUNAWAY was jostled at the break then outrun.
