Footnotes

ALCOLITE attended the pace maker from just off the inside, seized a narrow advantage at the five-sixteenths, got set down nearing the quarter pole, drew clear under a drive to the wire kept to task. HE HAS CHARM bumped at the start when FRONT broke outwards, set the pace along the inside, got displaced at the five-sixteenths as the pressure intensified, cut the corner roused into the stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on clear and second best. FRONT broke out at the start bumping HE HAS CHARM, settle just off the pace from just off the inside, lost position while unhurried to the far turn, came under urging at the three-eighths, bid mildly regaining some position to secure the show while unable to threaten the top two. DRIVENBYCHOCOLATE veered in at the start, tracked the pace along the inside from close range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and weakened. FUNKY CAT broke awkwardly and was off last, saved ground towards the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch improving his position then made no further headway. WISE GUIDE overland towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out and passed tired rivals in the stretch. SEVENTY SIX bumped at the start off pressure from FRONT breaking outwards, chased three to four wide in close range getting fully extended midway on the turn and weakened. PRIVATIZE settled mid pack four deep, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, faded in the latter portion of the turn, cornered five wide for home and tired. EVERYOTHERDAYHERO crossed to the inside after the start and briefly steadied in behind WISE GUIDE into the first turn, raced two to three wide towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths and tired.
