BOX OFFICE tracked inside, then moved up to press the pace, bid midway on the turn, drew clear past midstretch and was eased up nearing the finish. VISIONARY MAN had a ground saving trip and rallied for second. GRAND CONTENDER set the pace, dug in when challenged and weakened late. PHOTON raced three wide on the backside, came through on the rail entering the stretch and failed to threaten. TERMINUS chased three wide and tired. GRANDPA LEN chased between rivals and tired. MINESCAPE raced between foes and faded. PRAETORIAN GUARD raced four wide early and was outrun.
