DEBRENO was hustled along outside, finished determinedly once straightened away for the drive and was along in the final yards, driving. COUNTING VISIONS raced close up in the early stages, responded when roused, earned the lead in deep stretch and continued on well but could not withstand the winner. AIR KARAKORUM contested the pace while between rivals and continued on well to the finish. ROBIN'S GEMME chased the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. BROADWAY MISS contested the pace along the inside, drew clear in the stretch and gave way late. AUSABLE broke sluggishly, raced inside and was steadied while caught in traffic in deep stretch. GOSH ALL GET OUT was hustled along early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. RAGTIME TUNE stumbled at the start, raced inside and was bumped soundly in the stretch. THE DOCTOR ISA PRO was bumped soundly in the stretch. PERSONAL JEWEL hit the gate at the start, was bumped after the start, raced inside, was forced to steady in the stretch and altered course. CRYSTAL SALUTE was bumped at the start, was hustled along early and had no response. SADIE IS A LADY raced wide and tired.
