Footnotes

TIGHTEND TOUCHDOWN hustled inside from the start, set a solid pace off the inside under urging, inched away through the turn, got roused at the head of the lane and edged clear under a drive holding his nearest pursuer at bay. POINT TAKEN three wide in mid pack, progressed with a three wide move in the turn coming under urging at the three-eighths pole, drifted under near sided stick work in upper stretch, proved unable to reel in the top one while clear and second best. TALENTED WHIZ towards the rear just off the inside, got spirited up three furlongs from the wire, offered up a mild kick in the late stages to garner the show while never threatening the winner. SHOTGUN CITY broke out at the start, chased from the two path between foes in the turn and offered no serious bid before weakening very late on. DEVOTED WILDCAT lightly urged tracking from just off the pace, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. DAN'S GOLD two to three wide in mid pack, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch and tired. RKATSITELI three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths and was outrun.
