### Footnotes

BEAUTIFUL BUT BLUE was taken in hand soon after the start, reacting to her stable mate being pulled off another at that juncture, assumed a good forward position placed in the three path, cruised up to draw alongside the leader during the run around the bend, needing little encouragement to do so, was unleashed when ready as the field headed into the stretch, swerved inward and outward during the ensuing furlong, moving in opposition to whichever direction the rider's stick work was being applied, completed the decisive score under a mild hand ride the final sixteenth. VICKI'S DANCER broke well behind the competition after getting away awkwardly, was allowed to settle into stride, picked up the pace upon departing the backstretch, advanced into contention in the two path under her own power on the turn, got called upon entering the stretch and finished willingly enough to be second best. FRENCH LAUNDRY stumbled at the start, saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole and rallied mildly for the show. SHEA GOODBYE vied for the lead from the inside for a half and tired. BAIT broke inward slightly and brushed with KING OF THE DISCO before being successfully pulled off, was coaxed along disputing the pace between opponents for a half and gave way. KING OF THE DISCO urged nearly from the get-go, faded off a ground-saving journey.
