### Footnotes

COOSADA squeezed at the start by an errant UNBRIDLED DANGER into BEST ACTOR who broke a bit outward, recovered to settle towards the rear early, saved ground throughout, came under a drive at the head of the stretch, took over the front near the three-sixteenths, continued under a drive, drifted out through the final sixteenth in spite of the instructions of the rider while safe. TAKE DOWN TWO bided time early on, was placed three wide in the turn, swung out two additional paths at the head of the stretch now fully engaged by the rider, displayed a strong kick down the center of the lane to procure the place. MOST HAPPY FELLA under the whip early to establish the front, vied from the two path early on, took over the front near the quarter pole and led briefly until the three-sixteenths, steadily weakened from that point on, altered course near the wire, settling for show honors. BEST ACTOR saved ground early on, altered four wide at the quarter while under rousing, made a mild bid for the last major share. METROLOGY three to four wide throughout, was roused at the head of the lane, offered up a mild bid passing tired rivals. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE took the overland route and had no response. ZIPTRONIC rank under restraint while keen from the get go, chased three wide around both turns, loomed at the quarter pole, was let out from restraint and faltered. UNBRIDLED DANGER broke in at the start bumping COOSADA, was corrected by the rider, dueled inside for three quarters and gave way. There was a claim of foul by the rider of MOST HAPPY FELLA against COOSADA alleging interference in the stretch that was disallowed prior to the race being declared official.
