### Footnotes

MASPETH PRINCESS away in good order, was rated while contesting the pace two wide, continued along on the same scenario for nearly a half, wrested away the lead from a more energetically-handled opponent approaching the quarter pole and was soon let out herself, edged away from the field and held sway, driving. BLUE SIXTY FOUR was steadied at the start to avoid making contact with an errant MOJITO MINT, tucked along the inside, rode the rail down the backstretch and around the bend, picked up interest while being lightly asked for some run leaving the half mile pole, angled outward in the upper stretch and took off in earnest after the leader, made steadily progress on the top one, split rivals at the sixteenth pole and closed well to garner the place. MOJITO MINT broke outward at the start, was grabbed hold and put back on a truer course, took up the chase on the front runners from the outside, was asked for a response early on the turn to keep pace, got out kicked by the top pair during the last eighth and had to settle for the show. SWEET ADELINE argued for command from the inside and weakened in the final furlong. CARROT THIEF bumped soundly between foes at the start, went by tired and weak ones in the stretch en route to improving position. LA JOLLA LU chased the disputed pace from the two path, was roused shortly before reaching the five-sixteenths pole, tired. LEGIONS STAR bumped at the start, failed to menace. CLEAN JEAN was bumped at the break, kept a watchful eye on the front combatants from the three path for almost a half and gave way. TAXICAP saved ground on the turn and offered little.
