BALANCE OF POWER unhurried in the two path for the opening six furlongs, picked up interest when asked to at the five-sixteenths marker, got tipped outward and issued a challenge as the widest off three front runners as the field headed into the stretch, took over and shook free during the run through the furlong grounds and drew off. PONTUS disputed the pace from the two path, was between rivals at the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner while remaining sufficiently clear for the place. STRONG DEFENCE bumped at the start, got fanned into the seven path spinning into the stretch and went on to rally for the show award. KANTURK KID came inward leaving the starting gate, made solid contact with STRONG DEFENCE, raced at a considerable distance from off the rail throughout, angled four wide into the stretch, flattened out. REVELATIONIST saved ground, was under a drive by the three-eighths pole, had no rally. FAKE DREAMS three wide on the opening bend, folded. SUMMIT COUNTY three wide on both turns, tired. HOPPY DO was never

involved WIND OF BOSPHORUS vied for the lead along the inside, gave way. UNDER REVIEW never in the hunt, got eased entering the stretch.
