FEE AND SUGAR patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path, got roused approaching the top of the lane, picked up real estate readily, getting up near the wire to prove best. IT'S EASY got rated along from the inside on a loosely-contested lead, showed good determination before getting collared. JCS AMERICAN DREAM raced from off the rail, got asked for a response at the five-sixteenths pole, had no late offering. FIRE SHIP stumbled inward awkwardly, brushing with WILLOW U, travelled three wide on each bend, was under encouragement well before entering the stretch four wide, had no rally. ZAFIRO AZUL along the inside for most of the opening six furlongs, went by some weak and tired ones after getting angled out. FLYING K C strung out four wide on the first turn, tired. UNDER SCRUTINY saved ground to no avail. SHADES OF INDYGO tucked quickly along the rail, was no factor. ON A SNOWY EVENING two to three wide to the quarter pole, tired. WILLOW U brushed at the start, was three wide and roused midway on the second bend, failed to respond.
