Footnotes

DON TITO gave chase primarily four wide on the turn, moved up into a stronger contending position coming to the quarter pole, challenged in earnest a sixteenth down the road, wrested away the advantage with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away. SENSATIONAL SLAM unhurried off the inside in the early going, swung five wide into upper stretch, got straightened away and came home with good energy down the middle of the strip to garner the place. TENANGO rated while holding the lead to upper stretch, yielded in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and weakened into the show slot. HANNIBAL LECTER two to three wide prompting the pace for a half, gave way. PRIVATE TALE tracked the top one from near the inside, came up empty. HAVERHILL three wide on the turn, was outrun. RAVALO in the four path leaving the backstretch, got asked for run nearing the five-sixteenths marker, tired. ISTHMUS stumbled at the start, failed to menace off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
