STOP FOR SCHNAPPS was bumped at the start, was unhurried along the inside, came wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused and was clear under the line, driving. DIVERSA was bumped at the start, raced close up while in hand, rallied three wide on the second turn and stayed on gamely but could not resist the winner. CARAFE showed good speed along the inside and weakened on the rail in the final furlong. FALLING SNOW put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. IRISH GINGER had no rally. LA CAT raced wide and tired. NORTHERN ENERGY tired after three quarters. PRADEAU was bumped at the start, raced inside and tired.
