DANCING BLUES rated close to the pace from the inside, was eased to the outside of the top two entering the stretch, sustained a long drive through the stretch and moved clear in the final yards. STREET WHEELING moved to the lead rating the pace, was tested inside through the stretch, dropped back from the lead in midstretch then came back gamely to get place. MULTIPLE WINS stalked the pace, dueled to a short lead in the upper stretch, maintained that edge to late stretch, was outfinished for the win then missed the head bob for place. OUR BREADWINNER broke out bumping MARNIE'S WISH at the start, advanced under a hold nearing the turn, lacked room through the turn, was eased out in the upper stretch and offered no rally. LIVEITUPNOW rated close to the pace, was four wide on the turn then empty in the stretch. MARNIE'S WISH was bumped and bobbed at the start, saved ground and offered no rally. BLUE'S MAGEE angled out steadying at the start, raced closest through the backstretch then dropped back widest at the quarter pole and tired.
