TAMBURELLO (CHI) rated off the pace in the four path, assumed control four wide approaching the quarter pole, was clear a furlong away then widened with steady encouragement. COLITA rated off the pace in the three path, started his bid into the final turn and endured a long drive to get place. HYDROGEN rated the pace inside, was pressured toward the quarter pole, dueled briefly in the upper stretch, gave way to the winner then outfinished for place. NEW YORK HERO rated off the pace and off the rail, was boxed in toward the rail on the final turn then finished evenly. COUNTRY BE GOLD, unhurried off the rail, bid three wide on the final turn but proved empty in the stretch. DR. ROCKETT was unhurried inside and offered no rally. LIMERO (ARG) rated off the pace about the three or four path then drifted out weakening on the final turn. AMERICAN STYLE rated with the early pace inside then faded nearing the final turn.
