DRIVEN BY SOLAR away well, was lightly urged to establish early command, cut the pace towards the inside with the rider applying rating tactics, responded positively to encouragement swinging into the stretch, left the furlong grounds with his biggest advantage and held safely under a hard drive to the finish line. BLACK PEN put under a firm hold, patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path, was asked to pick up the pace coming to midpoint on the turn, continued the chase after entering the stretch but had to settle for place honors. NEW YAWKER saved ground until being angled off the rail in upper stretch, came outward several paths under a stiff left handed whip, taking SUNRISE SMARTY along for the ride as a result, kept a straighter course during the last eighth and successfully fended off the aforementioned rival to preserve the show. SUNRISE SMARTY was grabbed hold of after breaking outward slightly at the start, advanced into a forward position soon after departing the gate, underwent a three wide pursuit during the run around the bend, was herded outward by the show rival soon after settling into the stretch, continued onward well but came up short for the show photo. SIX FLINGS was steadied at the start, after displaying intentions of ducking inward, continued along rankly while being maneuvered over to the rail before reaching the half mile pole, took the inside route thereafter and failed to menace. BULLS AND BEARS raced along the outside and was outrun.
