Footnotes

LEMON SPLENDOR sat reserved from off the inside for almost six furlongs, got placed in the three path at the five-sixteenths pole, in preparation for the stretch drive, entered the lane and was asked for run, got hooked up in a duel with the third place finisher nearing the furlong marker, put that away before going a sixteenth down the road, then drew clear under good handling. PROUD AND CHARMING loped along at the back of the pack while taking the inside route, swung to be three wide at the top of the stretch, remained under a mild hand ride for the initial portion of the stretch drive, was put to intermittent left handed stick work with about an eighth to go and came home with good, but belatedly energy to procure the place. DOUBLE MINT bid for the lead from the two path around the far turn, took over to grab a narrow advantage, but was soon hard-pressed by the eventual winner, succumbed to the pressure and weakened in the final furlong. BERNING CARBS lightly bumped at the start, got locked up a tussle with DOUBLE MINT during the run around the bend, remained in the fight until upper stretch and gave way. MON ROSE came in sharply, making solid contact with the nearest foe, went on to take the inside route, was urged along on the far turn, but came up empty. FULL OF INTENT stumbled after bumping soundly with MON ROSE, then bounced off that opponent into BERNING CARBS, proceeded to be strung out three wide on the opening bend, but was closer to the rail on the subsequent one, came under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, but could make no headway on the front runners.
