WHO'S THE COWBOY away in good order, was guided to the rail coming to the half mile pole, steadily advanced while taking the inside route under light encouragement until the vicinity of the quarter pole, angled outward for the stretch drive, rallied earnestly once fully roused, closed in, taking over just as the field hit the eighth pole, then drew off from that point under a strong hand ride. THE ZIPSTER contested the pace from the three path with a pair of opponents, poked a head in front as that threesome turned for home, clung to a narrow edge during the ensuing furlong, had no answer when the top one arrived on the scene, readily relinquishing the front, but continued onward with good courage to be well clear of the others for place honors. CIRES rushed up into a forward position when given some rein soon after breaking away from the gate, battled from between rivals for command until upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. BOSTON CHIEF off to a alert beginning, met pressure from a pair of rivals after completing the initial furlong, fought from the rail with that twosome for command before beginning to back off approaching the three-sixteenths pole. BROKEN HOME taken out to the two path for the run around the bend, folded after going a half. B B FRANK three wide around the turn, never reached a contending position, then crossed the wire a bit choppy-gaited for the final check.
