Footnotes

BUDGE MAN reserved along the outside during the initial half, began to pick up the pace while being swung wide, departing midpoint on the second turn, settled into the five path after turning for home, rallied in earnest once given his cue, collared the leader a couple of jumps past the sixteenth pole, and dug in stubbornly to preserve the edge, refusing to be intimidated when TAR BEACH drifted out a bit deep stretch. TAR BEACH underwent a three wide journey, sat patiently perched within striking distance behind the pacesetter, ranged up to apply some pressure from the three-eighths pole, with the rider still trying to keep something in reserve all the while, forged to the front nearing the furlong marker, failed to keep pace with the top one with a sixteenth to go, readily giving way to that opponent, but continued on with good courage to be well clear of the others for the place. SCIBELLI rated while staking the leader from off the inside for three-quarters, made a challenge for command from the quarter pole to the eighth pole before backing off. TIMELESS CLASSIC hung out three wide on the first turn, was even wider by the five-sixteenths pole, had no stretch offering to give. ADAMS CIRCLE rated under a firm hold hold, gave way after turning for home. RISES THE PHOENIX steadied in tight behind rivals nearing the end of run around the first turn, continued along down the backstretch under a snug grip, was roused from three-eighths pole from between rivals but failed to muster up a solid kick. EAGLE STRIKE spotted the field a couple of lengths at the break after throwing his head a second or so before the field was sent off and running, raced rankly until nearing the backstretch, proceeded to travel in the three path on the far turn and gave way after going six furlongs. EMPIRE EXPRESS tracked the leader during the opening three-quarters under a firm hold and faded.
