Footnotes

BROCK N ROLL bobbled at the start, took up position in midpack from off the inside, sat within good striking distance throughout most of the opening half, picked up the pace during the later stages of the run around the bend, was let out entering the stretch, gained readily on the front runners, reaching the front at the eighth pole, but with several others still in close proximity and in hot pursuit, edged away from that station to the wire being hand urged to the end. SCORPER tracked the pacesetter, placed just slightly off the rail, was scurrying by the left side of TELL ME FIRST when the rider lost the whip, a short distance from the furlong marker, continued on willingly thereafter to procure the place. DIGGER KARAKORUM loosely drafted behind the leader in the two path around the bend, made a mild bid from upper to midstretch before getting out finished by the top twosome. CALLMETONY reserved in the two path for the initial half, tipped outward for better racing clearance in upper stretch, failed to fire when called upon. EVEN FRISKY saved ground on the turn and failed to reach a contending position. MITIGATION three wide on the turn, had no rally. PEGASUS ENA swung four wide into the lane and outfinished a few weak and tired ones for minor spoils. TELL ME FIRST showed the way from the two path, came under pressure after turning for home and readily succumbed to it before completing the run through the furlong grounds. DAKOTA ROADHOUSE got out hustled, was taken hold of momentarily when between rivals in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, was put back to encouragement after that incident, tired. THUNDERING ROAR raced along the outside, was asked for a response by midpoint on the turn, came up empty.
