WON GREAT CLASSIC vied between rivals, gained a short lead in upper stretch and drew clear late, driving. DAWLY stalked outside, came wide into the stretch and rallied mildly outside. SAINTS ALIVE vied inside, dug in gamely and stayed on for the show. LINDELL A. C. chased between early, then saved ground and closed belatedly on the rail. SIETE MACHOS raced off the pace inside and had no rally. EQUIVOCATION raced off the pace, came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. TAZERRED vied four wide early, bid three wide on the turn and tired. THE VIN MAN raced off the pace between rivals and failed to threaten. D' SAUVAGE raced three wide and did not factor.
