Footnotes

JEREK DETER just off the pace saving ground, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, rallied inside the final eighth to wear down the leader along his inside digging in to get up in the final strides and prevail. MY WAY OR DUBAIWAY hesitated at the start conceding three to four lengths, rushed up to prompt the pace four wide into the turn, took command nearing the three-eighths pole and inched away, got placed to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, inched clear to the furlong grounds, dug in fighting on to the wire but was caught in the final strides and forced to settle for the place. SUNRISE LOVER broke out at the start bumping TAKE THE EL TRAIN, chased three wide coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, kicked home mildly outside a pair but was ultimately out kicked by the top twosome to the wire. WOBURN saved ground towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide in upper stretch, rallied mildly late on for the last major share while never threatening the top. SLIMSHADY on the pace inside accompanied and under some pressure by a trio, got displaced at the three-eighths pole, came under urging nearing the five-sixteenths in response then weakened in the stretch. RED SHOGUN two to three wide towards the rear, came under prolonged urging at the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and passed tired foes in the stretch. PATRIOTIC DUTY pressed the pace from the two path between foes to the three-eighths pole, retreated in the latter portion of the turn coming under a drive at the five-sixteenths and tired. TAKE THE EL TRAIN bumped at the start when SUNRISE LOVER broke outwards, chased four to five wide from mid pack, got called upon three furlongs out, shifted inside to cut the corner into the stretch and tired. FORMAL ATTIRE hustled from the gate, showed brief speed pressing three wide among with a trio, gave way prior to a half then was eased in the stretch.
