MASALA away well from the gate, worked his way to the front and to the rail midway on the opening bend, set the pace from there while being rated along, felt stiffer pressure halfway during the run around the far turn, briefly lost the lead turning for home, came back on to wrest command in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, then dug in under good handling to preserve the decision. MARILYN'S GUY patiently rode the rail under a good hold, drafted behind NO SHENANIGANS escaping to the outside approaching the five-sixteenths pole, tipped out to the four path at the head of the stretch before commencing to rally in earnest, closed with good energy down the middle of the strip to garner place honors. MAGIC LION pressed the pacesetter in hand towards the two path during the initial half, moved up readily to wrest the lead away late on the second turn, succumbed to the top one's re bid in upper stretch and weakened steadily thereafter. NO SHENANIGANS contently tracked the front runner under a firm hold while taking the inside route, found ample room to angle three wide approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was set down after settling into the lane but came up empty. NACHO FRIEND bobbled at the start, sat reserved along the outside within striking distance, fanned into the lane from the four path but had no serious stretch offering to give. FINE FLYER was never involved.
