### Footnotes

WHATEVERITTAKES away in good order, sped past the field under his own power to establish command, carved the pace under a snug hold for nearly three-quarters, responded well when let out a notch in upper stretch and drew off to a lengthy score under hand encouragement. THUNDER CHIEF between rivals for most of the running, angled into the three path at the top of the lane, and finished a non-threatening second. GOLD CLOSE TO HOME saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole, hesitated for a stride or two coming to the eighth pole before angling further out and rallied mildly to grab the show. MR. HOOKER rated tracking the leader from the inside, came up empty for the stretch run. LEATHERHEAD saved ground and was failed to menace. ONTOTHENEXTONE three wide around both turns, bid briefly from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-eighths pole before backing off. SHOTGUN BANDIT reserved along the outside, was through after completing three-quarters. GAME TOKEN swung three wide into the lane, and had no rally.
