Footnotes

MAXANA made light contact with opponents from either side at the start, moved up in a contending position racing down the backstretch, continued to chase the leader from near the inside on the second bend, under some encouragement from the pilot, got angled sharply three wide for the commencement of the stretch, drove past the pacesetter to take over a short distance from the eighth pole, stayed clear, kept to strong handling. SHEEDBDAWON raced from off the inside, was in the three path at the five-sixteenths pole, took the same one for entrance into the stretch while under a drive, grabbed the place. KATE IS A TEN leapt up, brushing the right side of the starting gate, brought up the rear of the pack for the opening half, moved up gradually from the three path during the run around the far turn, got fanned six to seven wide making her way through the furlong grounds, rallied willingly enough for the show award. BARGAINING TABLE broke near the top despite ducking out at the start, kicked clear of the others and settled near the two path, set the initial three fractions on a loosely-contested lead, came under assault from the winner right after spinning into the stretch, got collared prior to the eighth pole and backed away. IVANOVNA lightly bumped at the start, raced three wide on both turns, tired after going six furlongs. BUNHEAD gave chase being primarily two wide and folded. HOOKED AGAIN broke through the starting gate, proceeded to come away with no apparent incident, worked out a tuck into the two path midway on the opening turn, tired. WHY NOT HER bumped at the start, faded off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
