Footnotes

MOMENTS NOTIZ broke alertly and maintained a prominent position throughout, drew directly alongside EXLEY coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, was a long neck in front a sixteenth down the road, was near the three-sixteenths pole before finally getting asked for run, gave it, kicked well clear and stayed so, crossing the wire under strong hand encouragement. FRAZIL underwent a ground-saving journey, proved no match for the winner while winning the fight for the place. QUICK MONEY gave chase primarily from the two path on the turn, was kept well in reserve for a half, swung five wide to the three-sixteenths pole, got outfinished for second. IN THE BEAT raced between rivals on the turn and had no rally. HEAD HEART HOOF stumbled badly at the start, was slow to settle into stride, appearing to climb for much of the opening quarter, commenced the stretch six wide, made no impact. SPECIAL SELECTION three wide departing the backstretch, never made his presence felt. SHOUTOUT drifted into the four wide at the three-eighths pole, drifted even more spinning into the stretch. EXLEY vied for command from the rail for nearly a half then gave way.
