NICK MISSED settled in patiently behind the pacesetter, was urged at the quarter pole and prevailed. TWO TURNS settled early and soon trailed the field before making a four wide advancement at the half way point and finished full of run. CURRAGH MON sprinted to a clear lead from outset and dictated pace before being engulfed by top two. KICK ROCKS was reserved off the pace for the opening half and finished willingly to close the gap. KANWIN SO MUCH made a mild bid from between horses and weakened to finish along the inside. BOILER BOB saved ground to no avail. SUCH A DEAL rated mid pack through the opening half and lost contact with the field in the closing stages.
