SHANGHAI VOYAGE within striking distance outside rivals from outset, came willingly four wide of rivals into stretch, took over mid stretch, unchallenged, ridden out. CRAFTY BRENT dueled from outset, no match for winner in drive but well clear of others for second best. BRITE MANEUVERS allowed to settle early, swung eight wide into stretch, responded to steady urging while mid track and got up for show spot. ASPEN MIST dueled along rail with a short lead into stretch, tired. CALL ME MR. CASH dueled for lead into stretch, gave way. T W HAMMERIN HANK well back from outset, failed to menace. FREDDY CAT was never a factor. LIVEFORPAT was never a threat. DOUBLE CREDIT was always outrun.
