SLAM A COCKTAIL finished willingly for second after hustling from outset to gain a ground saving stance. MERRY MIX UP was outfinished by top two in final furlong after hurrying from outset and gaining command and leading between calls. MAXIMUS THE GREAT rallied mildly to improve placing after settling mid pack in the early going. RUFF CUT showed late interest. A. P. WILDCAT passed tiring foes. LIGHT AFTER DARK lacked a late bid after showing reserve from outset. MACHO MOONO steadily faded. SUPER SNITCH bolted in the turn and lost rider near the quarter pole.
