JUNGLE RAJ loomed two deep into the turn, responded to urging and prevailed for the score. RIGGAN showed reserve in the opening half and rallied to earn place while being outkicked in final strides. WARLOCK WARRIOR opened up a clear lead in opening half and yielded to rallying rivals in final furlong. GOLDANDSILVER finished with strong strides to gain on leaders at finish. SANDY BOB rallied mildly to improve placing after rating back in the early going. KANWIN SO MUCH pressed the pace early and weakened in crucial portion of contest. KICK ROCKS passed tiring foes. ZILVER faded rapidly after flashing early speed from outset. TOCCING MAN settled in a comfortable pose and tired mid track in final stages. LOVE TO BARRETT steadily weakened.
