SUNDAY ROMEO chased leader along rail from start, responded to steady handling in drive to take command and draw clear in late going. ROCO RAPIDO flashed speed from start, opened clear advantage into stretch, went gamely while tiring in drive. ROSS HOSSER raced in the middle of pack to stretch, finished with a mild mid track rally to gain third spot. CORPORAL TILLMAN well back while outside foes to stretch, dropped to rail in drive, finished with a mild rally. CALEDO broke alertly, was forwardly placed for half, gave way. MANOVAN stalked pace for half, faded. THE COMPANY VAN was never a factor. GLIDININTHECASH showed little. TAKEITTOTHEBANK raced wide throughout and outrun. SKIP'S BET forwardly positioned for quarter, dropped back steadily.
