SWEET DIXIE VAN stalked the leaders early, moved to rail to save ground around turn, gained command at top of stretch, kicked clear of field. ALWAYS BEE MINE set the pace from between foes early, led the field into top of lane, gave way to winner in final furlong. JAVA JITTERS raced close behind early pace, responded to urging at second call, dueled for lead at the quarter pole, lacked closing rally. CLASS TRANS ACTION broke sharply, was unable to maintain pace, chased throughout, never a factor. FLYING FACTOR shown early speed, gave way after half. ALL ABOUT MATY trailed throughout. NOCREAMNOBUTTER was outrun. LUCK BE A LANA was never close. PUCKER NOW shown brief foot, was eased after half, crossed finish.
