CAME WEST came away from outset unhurried and settled behind pacesetters down the backstretch before angling out at the quarter pole to rally and close well from mid track. PARIS IN APRIL stalked down the backstretch and sustained that position three wide through the turn before gaining command in deep stretch and was unable to fend off the winner. SWEET DIXIE VAN rallied along the rail and was nipped for place. SCHERZI finished full of run after tucking behind the frontrunners to save ground through the turn. SORTA SPECIAL faltered in the final furlong after dictating pace from between rivals. HINDU KUSH came up empty in the crucial portion of contest to end a route that started off unhurried and consisted of tight quarters through the turn. EXPONENTIAL lacked room shortly after the start and was forced to advance position through the turn wide ending with a necessity to alter course. SQUIGGLE trailed in the early ground and lost more ground through the turn with a wide trip. ILLUSIVE CRYSTALS failed to menace while travelling wide.
