COBRAMATIC gained command early, never gave up lead, drew clear in final furlong. SABINO STORM settled early to the outside of early pacesetters, made charge mid turn, winner too much to overcome. HUNTIN A HALO was off a bit slow, chased field into turn, got up late for show. SECRET CITY dueled for early lead, chased eventual winner through turn, outfinished in final strides. CALL TRANSFER trailed field early, lost ground into turn, improved position down stretch, passed tiring foes. PADDY BOY got away sharply, dueled for early lead, was unable to sustain bid, steadily faded. TOCCING MAN raced mid pack in early half, weakened in latter portion of race. FAVORITE TWIST saved ground to no avail. HARLOW ROAD showed little.
