BOURBON CAT stalked pace from start ,moved up to loom danger into stretch, tired. HOMERUN KING failed to menace. AUTOMOBILE was never a factor. PRINCE O'FLAME never threatened. RIVER STORM vied for early lead along rail, gave way before half. GRAY MATTERS was hung wide from start, outrun.
